## Unlearning and Relearning: Reinvigorating Self and System in Times of Renewal

April 23-26, 2022

**CALL FOR PROPOSAL FOR EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES**

**DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION: Monday, October 11<sup>th</sup>, 2021**

### Introduction

As one of the five founding partners of the CCME, the Canadian Association for Medical Education (CAME) is actively involved in promoting research and educational activities to support the mission of the meeting. It is with great pleasure therefore that CAME is organizing the Medical Education Research Symposium for CCME 2022. This is a call for proposals for the Symposium.

The purpose of the Medical Education Research Symposium is to examine a specific medical education research topic from a variety of perspectives. Symposia may feature different facets of the research topic, present alternative interpretations and/or contrasting points of view. This is an ideal opportunity for a group of medical educational researchers with a common interest, to integrate, synthesize and showcase research findings. It is also an ideal forum to present and get feedback on research in progress. Submissions are encouraged from educational researchers affiliated with different institutions sharing a common interest, or from researchers at a single institution wishing to profile a particular stream in medical education research.

### Proposed Format

The symposium will be held on Monday, April 25<sup>th</sup> from 10:00-11:30 AM. The suggested format is a series of 2-3 brief presentations (10-15 minutes each) followed by a discussant. The first presenter might give an overview of the research topic chosen; then the next 2 speakers could then present their own research related to this research topic. The first speaker might also be the discussant. The role of the discussant is to identify common or disparate themes raised through the presentations, and to suggest implications for practice (if applicable) as well as areas or questions requiring further research. This is only a suggested format. However, it is expected that the symposia include ample opportunity for interaction with those present at the session.

### Expression of Interest

Groups interested in leading such a symposium should provide a brief (no more than one page) overview (max. 600 words). It is to include an overall abstract for the symposium noting "overview" speaker's name, affiliation plus one abstract for each of the speakers presenting their research, along with their names and affiliations. Also include the topic, the significance to research in medical education, and name of the discussant, if different than the other speakers.

The deadline to submit is October 11<sup>th</sup>, 2021

The moderator of this session will work with a member of the Education Research Symposium Planning Committee and the CCME secretariat to organize the symposium.
